The Alabama Board of Examiners in Psychology Requirements

20 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period.

Licenses must be renewed annually. The renewal period spans from October 1st to September 30th.

60 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period. At least 40 hours must be Category 1 courses and at least 20 hours must be Category 2 courses. All licensees are required to complete 4 hours in ethics and 4 hours in domestic violence or child abuse.

Licenses must be renewed every 2 years by April 30th of each odd-numbered year. (i.e.: 2013; 2015 etc.)

The California Board of Psychology Requirements

36 hours of Continuing Education (CE) are required for each 2-year renewal period. A minimum of 25% (9 hours) must be "live." Webinars in which there is interaction with the instructor in real time (via instant messaging, for example), are considered "live".

Licenses must be renewed biennially prior to the expiration date listed on license.

10 hours of continuing education must be completed every registration period. Registration period means the twelve-month period for which a license is being renewed.

For registration periods ending after January 1, 2016, each licensee must complete at least two contact hours of education (and at least once every six years thereafter) on the topic of mental health conditions common to veterans and family members of veterans.

The Delaware Board of Examiners of Psychologists Requirements

40 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period. Effective as of the license renewal period beginning August 1st, 2009, all Psychologists must complete 3 hours of continuing education in ethics.

Licenses must be renewed biennially. The license period extends from August 1st of the year of renewal to July 31st of the second year. Psychologist licenses and Psychological Assistant registrations expire on July 31st of odd years (i.e. 2013; 2015 etc.)

30 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period.

To qualify for the renewal of a license, an applicant shall complete thirty (30) hours of valid continuing education during the two (2)-year period preceding the date the license expires, which shall also meet the following requirements: (a) At least fifteen (15) hours of valid continuing education shall be completed in live program(s); and (b) An applicant seeking to renew his or her license on or before December 31, 2017 shall complete three (3) hours each in ethics and cultural competency; or (c) An applicant seeking to renew his or her license on or before December 31, 2019 and thereafter shall complete two (2) hours of LGBTQ continuing education.

The Florida Board of Psychology Requirements

For Initial Licensure

Psychologists are exempt from the CE requirements for renewal with the first biennium the exception of:

- 2 hour course relating to prevention of medical errors

For Renewal of License Following Your First Biennium

Psychologists must complete 40 hours of approved continuing psychological education (CE) within the two-year licensure period (biennium). The requirements are:

- 2 hours of continuing psychological education on domestic violence must be completed every **third** biennial licensure renewal period. These 2 hours shall be part of the 40 hours.
- 3 of the 40 hours must be on professional ethics and Florida Statutes and rules affecting the practice of psychology. Of those 3 hours, at least 1 hour shall be on professional ethics, and at least 1 hour shall be on Florida laws and rules relevant to the practice of psychology.
- 2 of the forty 40 hours must relate to prevention of medical errors, including a study of root-cause analysis, error reduction and prevention, and patient safety.

Passage of the laws and rules examination of the Board constitutes 40 hours of continuing education credit, including credit for professional ethics and Florida Statutes and rules affecting the practice of psychology. Passage of the laws and rules examination, however, does not satisfy the requirement for the 2 credit hours of continuing education on domestic violence required every third biennial licensure renewal period, or the requirement for 2 hours relating to prevention of medical errors.

24 hours of continuing education are required every renewal period. (Beginning with the September 30, 2014 renewal and ever renewal thereafter.) Licensees must complete at least 3 hours of content related to the ethical practice of Clinical Psychology.

Licenses must be renewed biennially. The renewal deadline is September 30th of even numbered years. (i.e.: 2014, 2016 etc.)

50 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period. During each renewal cycle and as part of the required continuing education hours, each licensed psychologist shall complete at least three education hours of training on professional ethics and at least six continuing education hours related to diagnosis and treatment of mental disorders.

Licenses must be renewed biennially. The deadline for license renewal is January 1st of each odd numbered year.

Psychologist

30 hours of continuing education credits to include:

- 6 hours of scientific and professional ethics and standards, and common areas of professional misconduct. Ethics course must be APA or Board approved and may be taken through distance learning.
- 2 hours of evidence-based suicide prevention and awareness. This is a new requirement placed on psychologists' license through the most recent legislative session, AB 93. Changes to NRS 641 and NAC 641 are in order to reflect the new requirement. The requirement is in place July 2016 - July 2026.

No license is allowed to have more than 15 distance learning credits.

40 CE credit hours, beginning with the first biennial license renewal after **June 19, 2018** (N.J.A.C. 13:42-10.20)

- Four CE credits must be related to domestic violence

Licenses must be renewed biennially. All licenses for psychologists expire on June 30th of each odd numbered year. All licensees will receive instructions regarding renewal approximately three months before the license expires.

(a) At least 20 of the required 40 CE credits may be earned through CE courses or programs related to the practice of psychology, one credit for each hour of instruction such courses from approved APA sponsors.

(b) Up to 20 of the required 40 continuing education credits may be earned from the following:

General Information about Continuing Education for Licensed Mental Health Counselors (LMHC)

Beginning January 1, 2017 each Licensed Mental Health Counselor (LMHC) must complete 36 hours of approved continuing education courses for each triennial registration period. No more than 12 hours of continuing education activities in any 36 month period, or one-third of the total hours in periods of other length, may consist of self-study educational activities from New York State Education Department approved providers.

50 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period. 4 CE hours in professional ethics of licensed psychologists. All active and semi-active licensees must complete a minimum of seven hours of continuing education dedicated to the topic of pain management.

This is a one time requirement.:

(a) One hour must be a course provided by the Oregon Pain Management Commission.

(b) The pain management requirement must be reported within twenty-four months of the first Renewal Notice and Affidavit.

30 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period. All licensees must complete at least 3 hours in ethics.

Licenses must be renewed biennially. The renewal period extends from December 1st of an odd numbered year to November 30th of the next odd numbered year.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2015, all persons applying for issuance of an initial license shall be required to complete 3 hours of DPW-approved training in child abuse recognition and reporting requirements as a condition of licensure. Additionally, EFFECTIVE WITH THE FIRST LICENSE RENEWAL AFTER JANUARY 1, 2015, all health-related licensees and funeral directors applying for the renewal of a license issued by the Board shall be required to complete at least 2 hours of Board-approved continuing education in child abuse recognition and reporting requirements as a condition of renewal.

The Tennessee Board of Examiners of Psychology Requirements

40 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period.

Licenses must be renewed biennially. The deadline for renewal is December 31st every 2 years; the year is dependent on individual licensure date.

The Texas State Board of Examiners of Psychologists Requirements

20 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period. All licensees must complete a minimum of 3 hours in ethics, the Board's Rules of Conduct or professional responsibility.

Licenses must be renewed annually. At least 30 days in advance of the renewal date, licensees are mailed a postcard to remind them that they need to renew their licenses. The renewal date depends on the initial licensure date.

The Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing Requirements

48 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period. All licensees must complete 6 hours in ethics/law.

Licenses must be renewed biennially. The deadline for renewal is September 30th of even-numbered years.

The Vermont Board of Psychological Examiners Requirements

60 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period. All licensees must complete a minimum of 6 credits of professional ethics, jurisprudence, and/or related legal issues.

Licenses must be renewed biennially on January 1st of even numbered years.

The Virginia Board of Psychology Requirements

14 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period. All licensees must complete a minimum of 1.5 hours in ethics, standards of practice or laws governing the profession of Psychology in Virginia.

Licenses must be renewed annually by January 1st.

The Washington State Department of Health Requirements

- 60 hours minimum of continuing education every three years for licence renewal. WAC 246-924-230.
- 4 hours minimum must be in ethics. Areas to be covered, depending on the licensee's primary area(s) of function are practice, consultation, research, teaching, or supervision.
- 6 hours of training in suicide assessment, treatment, and management every six years. Chapter 246-12 WAC, Part 14. RCW 43.70.442.
- 7 hours of AIDS education (one-time requirement). WAC 246-924-110 as required in Chapter 246-12 WAC, Part 8.

Psychology credentials must be renewed yearly. Every three years when a psychologist renews his or her license, they must be able to verify they have completed 60 hours of continuing education (CE). A minimum of four hours must be in ethics and, as of January 1, 2014, at least six hours of training in suicide assessment, treatment and management every six years is required.

Psychologists: 20 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period.

Licenses must be renewed biennially.

Licensed School Psychologists: 30 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period.

Licenses must be renewed every 3 years.

The Wyoming Secretary of State Requirements

30 hours of continuing education must be completed every renewal period.

Licenses must be renewed biennially. Both licenses and certificates expire June 30th of every 2 years. The year of expiration is dependent on the initial license date.

Continuing Education Requirements.

(a) As a condition for renewal, license and certificate holders must provide documentation of having completed thirty (30) hours of continuing education every two (2) years on their renewal date. These hours must be obtained during the forty-eight (48) months immediately preceding their renewal date. The period required to obtain continuing education hours may be extended by the Board if good cause is shown by the applicant.

(b) These hours may be earned as follows:

(i) Up to twenty (20) continuing education hours may be earned by completing designated activities reviewed and approved by the WPA or the WSPA for continuing education credit.

(ii) At least ten (10) continuing education hours must be earned by completing program designed activities reviewed and approved by the APA or NASP.

(c) It is the licensee or certificate holder's responsibility to obtain the necessary documentation of hours earned from the continuing education activity sponsor and to submit such documentation to the Board upon request.
